Delivery of patient-centered care

Comprehensive team approach at diagnosis and throughout the PD journey

The team consists of:

- Two movement disorder trained neurologists
- Designated CoE center coordinator
- Two nurse practitioners
- Three registered nurses
- Four medical assistants
- Social worker
- Neuropsychologists
- Health psychologist
- Clinical mental health counselor
- Physical therapist
- Occupational therapist
- Speech-language pathologist
- Other disciplines as appropriate (e.g., pharmacist)

PHQ-9 Depression screening study

Sleep disturbance screening ~ plans to resume/incorporate into the patient rooming/arrival process to improve sleep screening

Research

Ongoing clinical research studies

- Fixed-dose trial in Early Parkinson's disease (recruiting)
Drug: Tavapadon/ Drug: Placebo
- Flexible-dose, Adjunctive Therapy Trial in Adults With Parkinson's Disease with Motor fluctuations (recruiting)
Drug: Tavapadon/ Drug: Placebo
- Open-label Extension Study (OLE) Study of the Safety and Clinical Utility of IPX203 in Parkinson's Disease (PD) Participants With Motor Fluctuations (completed)
Drug: IPX203
- A Study to Evaluate the Safety and Efficacy of IPX203 in Parkinson's Disease Participants With Motor Fluctuations (completed)
Drug: C/L, C/L ER, Placebo matching IPX203, Placebo matching C/L
- We hope to be a future site for PDGeneration once trial funding evolves.
